Dr Jörg Polakiewicz has been working since 1993 at the Council of Europe. After having been with the Secretariat of the European Commission for Democracy through Law (Venice Commission), he exercised the functions of deputy head of the Council of Europe's legal advice department and treaty office between 2001 and 2004. He currently holds the post of head of the human rights law and policy division. He is also a lecturer at the Europa-Institut of the University of the Saarland in Saarbrücken.

From 1986 to 1993 he worked as a research fellow at the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public and International Law in Heidelberg. In addition to numerous articles on international, European and constitutional law, he is co-editor of *Fundamental Rights in Europe* (Oxford University Press 2001), author of *Treaty-making in the Council of Europe* (Council of Europe Publishing 1999) and *The Obligations of States arising from the Judgments of the European Court of Human Rights* (Springer) which was published in German in 1993.
