Prof. Kaye Chon is Dean and Chair Professor of the School of Hotel and Tourism Management at The Hong Kong Polytechnic University. In 2011, Prof. Chon received the **Ulysses Prize** from the United Nations World Tourism Organization. Commonly known as "Nobel Prize in Tourism," Ulysses Prize is annually given to one scholar for distinguished contribution to knowledge creation in tourism.

A frequent speaker at international conferences, Prof. Chon has published over 200 papers in international journals and professional publications and has authored or edited eight books. One of his textbooks **Welcome to Hospitality: an Introduction** has been adopted as a textbook in more than 100 hospitality and tourism schools worldwide. He is currently the Chief Editor of the **Journal of Travel & Tourism**Marketing and the Asia Pacific Journal of Tourism Research.
