Students are required to take **ONE** pair of the above English courses according to assigned level.

- Placement level "IE1": EELC1001/EELC110 in the first semester, and EELC1002/EELC120 in the second semester
- Placement level "IE2": EELC1002/EELC120 in the first semester, and EELC1003/EELC130 in the second semester
- Placement level "AE": EELC1003/EELC130 in the first semester, and one 3-credit English elective in the second semester
- Placement level "English Electives": One 3-credit English elective in **each** semester
