

DPRK at a Crossroad: Prospects for Change

Entering 2015, North Korea remains the most critical and uncertain factor to the peace and stability in the Northeast Asia security. Can the new leadership in DPRK bring political and economic stability to the country? Is the reconciliation between the United States and DPRK possible? Can the DPRK end its dangerous isolation returning to the family of the international community? Can concerned parties work together to remove the flash point of military conflict from the region? The conference will assemble a group of leading scholars from China, South Korea, United States Japan, Russia, and Taiwan to make an assessment of North Korea's domestic and foreign policy, its relations with major players in the region, and their implications for the various security issues in the region.
