

The Inaugural China-US-Japan Trilateral Academic Dialogue

There has been a sea change in Sino-US and Sino-Japanese relations since Xi Jinping came to power and each bilateral relationship impacts on the tripartite relations in a significant way. This workshop is intended to evaluate the changes as a new normal through exchange of views from three internationally famous scholars from the three countries:



Professor Jia Qingguo of the Peking University Professor Lyle Goldstein of US Naval War College and Professor Eiichi Katahara of Japan's National Institute of Defense Studies.
