French Revolutionary Culture and Modern Chinese Revolution

Abstract:

The political culture of the French Revolution has a profound impact on the whole process of the Chinese revolution in the 20th century. Not only did the “Xinhai Revolution” and its succession the “National Revolution” take place under the name of the French Revolution, but also the more radical “New Democratic Revolution” and later the “Socialist Revolution” led by the Chinese Communist Party had inextricably links with the French Revolution. Although the missions and goals of these revolutions are different, their fundamental principles are the same in an abstract sense. There are many shortcomings of this kind of French model revolutions that occurred in Modern China, yet one should not deny the historical inevitability and legitimacy behind them.

摘要：法國革命政治文化深刻影響了 20 世紀中國革命的全過程；不僅辛亥革命及其後繼的國民革命打的都是法國大革命的旗幟，而且即使是由中國共產黨領導的更為激進的新民主主義革命以及後來的社會主義革命，也同樣和法國的革命文化有著千絲萬縷的聯繫。中國共產黨的革命和法國大革命的任務、目標也許有別，但它們在抽象意義上的基本原則卻並無任何差異。發生在現代中國的這種法蘭西式的革命有很多弊端，但也有其不容否認的歷史必然性和正當性。
