Abstract

In this talk, Professor Unger will first discuss opportunities and challenges in China studies in a changing world. Our students, especially postgraduate students, will be able to share with him the challenges they are facing in developing their own research projects and writing dissertations. Professor Unger will give feedback, comments and suggestions with his experience of nurturing new generation of China studies scholars for decades.

Jonathan Unger is a Professor in the Political and Social Change Department at the Australian National University. He has published fifteen books, including *Education under Mao: Class and Competition in Canton Schools* (1982), *The Transformation of Rural China* (2002) and, as co-author, *Chen Village: Revolution to Globalization* (2009), and over eighty academic articles. He also has served as editor and co-editor (with Anita Chan) of *The China Journal* for 20 years. He first edited the journal from 1987 through 2005, and began editing it again two years ago.
